
#### MESSAGE FROM CHAIRMAN THEO

#### Flood victims are still needing help

John, a mature aged plumber in training, & partner Chantelle, a social worker, with their two small children, are amongst the many homeowners & renters in our local community who continue to bear the effects of the major floods earlier this year.

We continue to assist many flood victims, especially those very badly impacted.

John & Chantelle are homeowners – their home was severely flooded.

One of our partners, the Serve Team of the Camden Haven Anglican Church, as well as the Church Youth Group, have been painting at their home, along with some yard maintenance. We are currently getting quotes for wardrobes which can be covered by insurance money (which only goes so far), however, we need to source a tradesman who could instal them and also put in a day on fixing the laundry.
