OTHER NEWS ITEMS WHERE COMMUNITY at 3 HAS BEEN ASKED FOR HELP

CHILDREN IN NEED

Jade's parents are currently in gaol awaiting trial for the recent alleged murder of their daughter Elizabeth (8 years). Jade, their 19-year-old daughter has applied to Child Safety for permission to keep the other members of the family (6 children) together and to be their Carer. They will need a great deal of ongoing support. Community at 3 is involved in assisting them.



SO MANY OTHERS IN NEED

- Jim, not well physically, was sleeping in his car in Kew and looking for accommodation near a Hospital. Jim couldn't score a rental due to the low availability of housing all along the coast. Community at 3 has enabled him to find suitable accommodation he can afford within a short distance from Taree hospital.
- Ken, 93 years of age, not well and quite depressed, came to us for help. We have been able to assist him and he has now been admitted to care. He is greatly relieved.
