## **PUBLIC MEETING LAUNCHES** TRANSITIONAL ACCOMMODATION FACILITY APPEAL

Around 175 people attended (with over 50 apologies received) the recent public meeting held at the LUSC for the Transitional Accommodation Project Launch to be run by Community at 3. The vast majority of those attending fully supported the project. Once a DA is lodged, anyone with remaining questions or objections will have the opportunity to present them to Council. Thank you to all who attended and clearly indicated majority community support to help those in our community with short term accommodation assistance.

The main aspects of this facility are:

- ✓ a strongly controlled vetting process will be the hallmark of selecting residents
- ✓ a 3-month maximum stay will be enforced many will stay only days or a couple of weeks.
  - ✓ it is not a drop-in centre, drug rehabilitation centre or homeless shelter
- √ it will not be housing ex-prisoners, those with active drug addiction, alcoholism or abuse charges.
  - ✓ it will be fully staffed with onsite managers and security systems.
  - ✓ no drugs or alcohol will be on the premises no second chances will be given.
  - ✓ the rooms are for the temporarily homeless, those doing it tough in today's financial turmoil.
    - ✓ noise control, cleanliness and behavioural standards will be strictly imposed.
- ✓ our primary purpose is to assist those in need for the next step in their lives breathing space for those who may have lost their rental, their spouse, their job, their house or are in a financial crisis.
- ✓ all of the local aid agencies have agreed to provide support for all residents, to enable long-term housing, employment and assistance for all residents.
