It's an absolute privilege to be in a position where we are able to continue our partnership with the Community at 3, and it is an honour to be part of such a great team of Volunteers that always strive to make a difference to a lot of people out there in our Community.

LEARNE'S STORY - in her own words "... I first came to the Community at 3 BBQ in about 2020 as my cousin Bill was a regular. I was suffering several health issues including chest infection from the mould where I was living in Albert St., North Haven. In March 2021 the huge floods inundated my home up to my knees. My dear dog Azzie and I were rescued by boat. I lost so many of my belongings, so I went to live with my son at Bonny Hills. One month later I was diagnosed with stage 4 Follicular lymphoma from which I am currently in remission after 18 months of immunotherapy (not enjoyable). I suffer various other health issues including a low white blood cell count. After living with my 2 sons for



6 months at a time in Brisbane, I returned to the area and stayed with a friend for another 6 months, where Azzie was welcome. I reconnected again with Community at 3 and there met with two ladies who were so supportive of my need for accommodation: Michelle from the Dept of Housing and Jayne from New Horizons. Both worked hard to eventually find me a permanent home in Laurieton – OUT OF THE FLOOD ZONE! I thank them so much. I love all of the people at Community at 3. Alan has been a big help, especially delivering food to me and many others all during Covid. The ladies there are always so nice. For me, it's a happy place..."

- ✓ Another case of an elderly couple on benefits, husband died suddenly, widow (with health issues) evicted due to inability to pay rent. With her permission, we contacted her long-estranged family and, as with others before, we were able to reunite her with her family. Transport to the Newcastle area was also organised. So many separated families can reunite if only someone cares enough to intervene.
- ✓ Community at 3 continues to provide transport each week for those otherwise unable to travel to our free BBQ meal behind LUSC every Wednesday. We always have room for one more. Just let us know.
- ✓ Two men and one woman were assisted by Community at 3 in finding employment during the month of June.
- ✓ 15 people were assisted with food support by **Community at 3.**
- ✓ 36 people were supported with general advice and assistance.
- ✓ One family, grieving because of a sudden death, was given support.
- ✓ 3 people facing terminal illness were supported by Community at 3
 with loving care. Sometimes all someone needs to know is that people
 care a phone call, a cup of coffee or a short visit can be enough.

UPDATE ON A CASE

Some may recall a story regarding a young woman, Jayde, (mentioned in 2022 Newsletters #15-17) whose parents were charged with the murder of their 8yo daughter Elizabeth, Jayde's sister, and Jayde obtained custody of her remaining 5 younger siblings. Community at 3 was involved in assisting her & keeps in touch. Well, 18 months later they are doing well, having acquired a new motor vehicle big enough for all of them, and a new home in a new location. God bless them. Our thanks go out to all who were involved in assisting Jayde and her siblings.
