GLEN SECURES A PERMANENT HOME - after 4 years living in his car

".. I first came to know **Community at 3** in 2021, when I was in grave need of urgent dental work - I needed all my teeth removed. **Community at 3** assisted me and also paid for accommodation afterwards to enable me to recuperate. I have been homeless, residing in my car rooftop tent moving around the Camden Haven area since 2019. In 2022, I spent 13 days in hospital following heart failure. I remained homeless until, on 29 June 2023 - my 60th birthday - I received a call I will never forget. It was **Nathan** from **Community Housing** to say, "Come & see me tomorrow". I did, and he offered me a unit in Laurieton, and he said, "It is yours until you go upstairs". I thought he meant I'd have

to move upstairs sometime, but, no, he meant I can have the unit until I die. Was I excited!!

Since then, I have been trying to furnish it – you don't have a lot of furniture in a car rooftop tent! I have been helped with household items from all the local charities: Anglican Op-Shop, Aussie Battlers and Vinnies.

Can I say that **Zillah** from Vinnies (now also a Volunteer at Community at 3) helped me immensely.

She has been a Godsend. Can I also say to all those in need: If you're struggling like I was – keep on keeping on – something good will happen for you. Can I also say: **Community at 3** is second to none.

What you do for people in need is....(I've got no words for it)...God bless you all..." (Glen)
