".. On 13 July 2023 I celebrated 2 years living in my car. I was passing through the Camden Haven and just thought, "This place is nice." So I spent 6 months in a car park at Lake Cathie (the Police did tell me to move on); then another 6 months at Dunbogan. A good friend Glen then told me about **Community** at 3. I enjoyed the friendship and support I found there. But I thought I'd move on. After **Theo and Brian**, as well as Aussie Battlers, helped get my motor vehicle up and going, I left the area and just floated around. I then returned to the Camden Haven, still in my car. Zillah, who is a Volunteer at both Community at 3 and also at Vinnies, found a home for my friend Glen at Dunbogan. But just at the same time, Glen was offered a permanent unit in Laurieton from Community Housing. So, Glen asked Zillah could she see if I could have that place, saying, "I've got just the right fella for that house."





The owner agreed and I now have somewhere to call home. I am still on the long waiting list for a permanent place, but I am so happy to be out of my car. And Zillah has been an "Angel" to both Glen and me in the support she has given to us. I have returned to the fellowship of the weekly Wednesday BBQ behind the LUSC and continue to enjoy the support of **Community at 3..**" (Bob)
