# HOW DO WE QUALIFY THOSE WE HELP?

We have what we call at Community at 3 a "Community Care Process". Chairman Theo, who oversees our Community Care Team, describes it this way... "When assessing the level of assistance and support Community at 3 brings to people, we like to follow a process. We don't like third party referrals unless a full assessment has been made and we know the people making the assessment. It is the same with telephone requests - we like to meet in person. It is always our desire to support the person in the best way possible, so, with a careful interview, correct decisions can be made as to the best way forward. We have many requests for cash, and rarely do we give cash, and if a payment is required for support, we do this directly. Community at 3 will not see anyone go hungry, but it is our overwhelming desire to assist the whole person, and in some cases this may require re-connecting with family, re-connecting with society, finding employment, accommodation, Spiritual support etc. - and in all of these areas, we walk alongside the people, and offer ongoing support." # AMERICAN MOTORCYCLE CLUB DISPLAYS MORE GENEROSITY



# A RECORD MONTH

**Community at 3** had more than **150 people** request assistance in the past month. Amongst those requests, we transported numerous people to medical appointments, had requests from two other charities for advice/support, as well as reconnecting two estranged families. We exist to help others.

#### HOW WE SPEND YOUR MONEY

We'd like to inform you as to what we do with the funds & gift vouchers generously donated to Community at 3 by so many members of the community. The chart below gives a very broad picture. Rarely do we simply hand out cash to people in need – rather we discern needs and try to address them.



 COMMUNITY CARE – Food, food parcels & vouchers, accommodation and travel assistance, general support.
 WEEKLY BBQ MEAL – BBQ food (in addition to donated food), related equipment & supplies.
 VEHICLES – Registration, insurance, fuel & maintenance of our donated small sedan & 12-seater bus.
 OTHER – Public liability insurance & Volunteers Workers' Compensation insurance, sundry admin costs. No Volunteer is paid. Administration costs are negligible. Much is donated (including by Volunteers).
 In addition, 100% of money donated for the Transitional Homeless Accommodation Project is held in trust.
