

12,400 SIGNATURES

Leslie Williams MP has now delivered our Petition to State Parliament, containing 12,400 signatures, requesting the NSW Government to assist, with funding, our project to establish a permanent facility for emergency accommodation for the suddenly homeless in the wider Camden Haven area.

Leslie will be given the opportunity to speak to it in detail, and have it debated in Parliament, sometime during the month of May.

- ✓ transported 2 people to encology, 1 to Coffs Harbour & 2 to Kempsey
- √ found temporary accommodation for a family, following a fire in their home:
- ✓ gave assistance & support to 3 new people in their jobs;
- ✓ assisted in 3 mediations;
- ✓ are currently supporting a number of individuals with a terminal illness.

GUY AND ERIN FOUND HELP AND COMMUNITY



Guy has only been in the Camden Haven for 9 years, but Erin was born in Wauchope. They've lived in Lakewood for 9 years. Three years ago, Guy's sister recommended Community at 3, saying, "They have a free BBQ and can help you out with food etc." So, Guy and Erin came along and now feel part of the Community at 3 family. I asked them what did they find here. They replied, "We found community and a lot of friendly faces. People don't judge you here – and that's a big thing. We also found here friendship – and we have made a number of friends since first coming here. The free food is very helpful. We are both on pensions, paying off a car I never would have bought had I known inflation and prices of everything would climb so high. We truly love coming here and talking with people – most people I have met here are very friendly. We look forward to coming down here every Wednesday." Then Erin said something quite significant: "When we first came to Community at 3, I was suffering from "acute social anxiety". Now, 3 years later, I don't have anxiety very much at all. It has reduced immensely, and I am so much happier and relaxed."
